Reception held their annual cafe for loved ones today - it was lovely - thank you to all who attended! We have some very patient waiters in the making!


Incredible news now - we have secured funding for a brand new bespoke modular building for our new Nursery. Started in February 2023, our small but perfectly formed Nursery of 8 pupils has been sharing our Early Years area, but due to the incredible commitment of the Early Years staff and the provision that we have started, the Archdiocese of Liverpool have agreed to fund a new building. This has then been supported by Father Ian, who with the Parish Council, has gifted us the land immediately behind the Church for use. The new Nursery will be sited on this land and will share the rest of the area as a playground with our Reception class. Unfortunately due to contracting issues, the actual building work will not start until later this year (we will keep you posted), but in the meantime we will start to expand our provision by using the


