#### Online Safety

The police have started to produce a newsletter with some very handy information in regarding online safety. It is so hard to keep up to date with the technology and children can soon find themselves at risk. To help you keep up to date I will copy any information that I feel is relevant to primary children onto here:

The latest websites/social media apps that are concerning are:

Musical.ly is a video social network app for video creation, messaging and live broadcasting. User can create 15-second videos and choose sound tracks to accompany them. This has been known to be used by Paedophiles and is becoming increasingly popular.

Oovooo is being used by children as young as 9 years old this too is a video chat and instant messaging app.

Omegle is an anonymous webcam chat site which users don't need to register on or provide any proof of age. We have seen a dramatic increase in the number of youngsters tricked by paedophiles into believing they are watching a pretty young girl/boy, when in fact it is a video being played.

Chatstep is also starting to report more cases of IIOC and this appears to be another social media app that is becoming more popular. It allows users to create their own rooms, or join already created public rooms.

Yikyak is an app that has already been banned in 130,000 schools in the US. It has been described by one Dr in the US as "the most dangerous form of social media I have even seen" It is totally anonymous and allocates a symbol to each user which cannot be traced back.


