Dear Parents

Return to school

Most of you will be aware that this week schools received guidance on how we can bring all children back to school in September. I am busy working on the risk assessment but I can tell you so far that:

- Children will all return (in uniform) in September. School isn't optional and parents will be penalised for keeping children at home.
- Children will be taught in their usual year group classes of 30 ish. They will also be in bubbles of more than one class to facilitate lunches and Childrens' Club.
- We will be opening at the usual time (gates will open at 8.40). Children will enter through various class doors to prevent bottle necks. This is fairly staggered as it is. I will send further details about this and hometime when the risk assessment is complete.
- We will continue to promote regular handwashing, tissue hygiene and have regular cleaning down of surfaces.
- For the time being we will not congregate as a whole school but will continue to either Zoom or Microsoft Teams to classrooms.
- Staff will continue to wear PPE when dealing with bodily fluids and ill children.
- Staff will not be strictly restricted to the bubbles.

We cannot wait until everyone is back in school together. I know that many parents have struggled to keep their children at home when they could have sent them back but they have done this to keep staff safer. Thank you seems to be inadequate but please know that we are extremely grateful. However we are going to have to adjust to living in a world where this virus exists and work to keep us all as safe as possible. The full risk assessment will be released when I have completed and consulted with governors.
