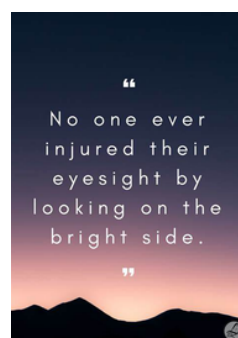
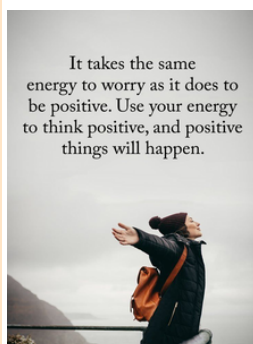
REMEMBRANCE DAY POPPIES FOR SALE
